
ABOUT OCHACHU

Ochanomizu Junior High school opened in 1875 at Ochanomizu and moved its campus to õtsuka in 1932. We are taught to be independent and responsible, and to have a wide perspective. These are Ochachu's educational objectives. Every morning, we pass in front of this stone monument on which these objectives are written.

The main gate of the university is designated as a tangible cultural property. Ochachu is located a little far from the main gate of the university, so we are careful not to be late for school in the morning.

NEW UNIFORM

In addition to the usual sailor uniform and school uniform, slacks will be introduced this fall. To make this uniform, the board of directors examined the results of a student questionnaire, and proposed a prototype to the uniform company. These wide pants are made to match a sailor with a belt, and the unique wide silhouette resembles a hakama. It reminds me of the time when Ochachu's roots, "Tokyo Women's Higher Normal School" and "Tokyo Women's Normal School Affiliated High School for Girls," had belts attached to their hakama. With this uniform, the students' wish to incorporate new things while inheriting tradition has come true.

Our school badge has an octagon mirror, orchid, and chrysanthemum as our motif.

SCHOOL SONG

The school song is "Migakazuba crystals and mirrors shall have something done, our learning paths shall be treated the same." This song was made by Empire Shoken, the emperor during the Taisho period.





In classes taught by native speakers, we often learn reading and writing. In the normal English class, we study English grammar, vocabulary, and communication. Sometimes we play games and sing songs. In the differentiated classes, we break into small groups depending on our English level.
